Programme Overview

The European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) is the main EU Structural and Investment Fund used to support economic development in countries and regions across Europe. Part of the ERDF funding that Northern Ireland receives is delivered through the Investment for Growth and Jobs (IGJ) Programme.

In Northern Ireland the IGJ Programme supports Research, Technological Development and Innovation, Enhancing the Competitiveness of SMEs and Supporting the Shift towards a Low Carbon Economy.

The Programme value is £427.8m.

Performance and Progress in 2016

The Programme aims to increase economic growth in Northern Ireland and has contributed to the following:

- Companies engaged in R&D for the first time has increased from a baseline of 495 in 2012 to 714 in 2016;
- The number of small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) classified as high growth companies has increased from a baseline of 695 in 2013 to 845 in 2016; and
- Employment within micro and small businesses has increased from a baseline of 297k in 2013 to 313k in 2016.
